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Can the Board of Nursing require evaluation for substance use disorder during an investigation?



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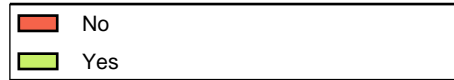
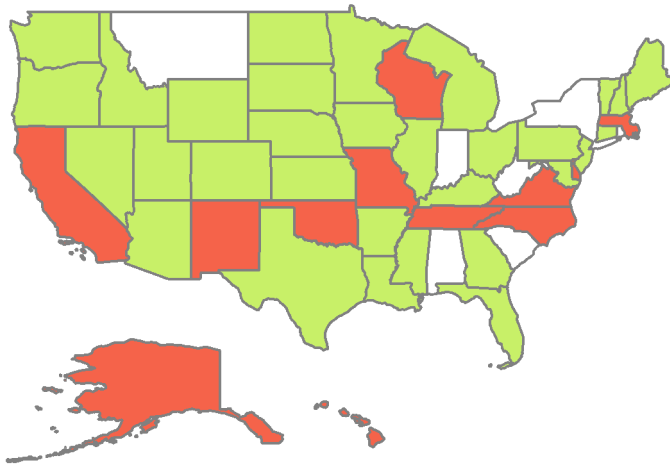
