Introduction

In collaboration with your board of nursing (BON), NCSBN is assisting with collecting their Annual Report data this year. Your BON will receive descriptive results of the nursing programs in their state/jurisdiction, as well as a report of the raw data of each program. Annually, they will receive an aggregate report of all participating BONs so that they can compare their programs to the aggregate.
