NCSBN Model Act	<p><b>Section 9. Criminal Background Checks</b></p> <p>Each applicant for licensure shall submit a full set of fingerprints to the BON for the purpose of obtaining a state and federal criminal records check pursuant to &lt;state statute&gt; and Public Law 92-544. The &lt;state agency responsible for managing fingerprint data&gt; may exchange this fingerprint data with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).</p>
NCSBN Model Rules	<p><b>5.9 Criminal Background Checks</b></p> <p>a. All individuals convicted of a sexual offense involving a minor or performing a sexual act against the will of another person shall be subject to a BON order for evaluation by a qualified expert approved by the BON. If the evaluation identifies sexual behaviors of a predatory nature the BON shall deny licensure.</p> <p>b. Other criminal convictions may be reviewed by the BON on a case by case basis to determine eligibility for licensure.</p>
