NCSBN's Scholar in Residence Program advances the field of nursing regulation by building regulatory experts and researchers, providing high-level evidence for nursing regulatory and policy decision making, and encouraging scholarly dialogue and publications.



Who: Doctoral student or faculty member

When: The position begins in the summer of 2025 or as agreed upon by the applicant and NCSBN staff

Consists of an eight-week, full-time, paid experience that will provides the doctoral student or faculty member with valuable nursing regulatory/policy experience related to education, practice, licensure, policy and/or discipline depending on both the scholar's primary area of interest and NCSBN's organizational objectives. The scholar will work under close guidance of the Director of Nursing Education and Policy and will be assigned to specific staff based on the area of interest.

Financial Support: Stipend and housing allowance (if relocation is required).
