


Dissemination of Horse in West






Great Plains Indian Migrations


























- 1803: Establish Base Camp at St. Louis
- 1804: Ascend the Missouri River to the Mandan Villages, where they spend the winter.
- **1805:** Ascend the Missouri River to the Rockies and cross over to the Columbia River and on to the Pacific Coast.
- 1806: Return by Columbia and Missouri Rivers to St. Louis.
