During her tenure as President, the Board for Nursing implemented the Nurse Licensure Compact. She also served as an interim NLC Commissioner. As an associate professor at New Jersey City University, she is responsible for clinical and theoretical instruction, academic advising and supervision, and evaluation of students and patient assessment. She serves as a peer reviewer for the "Nurse Education in Practice" journal.

She has been recognized as a grant recipient for the Robert Wood Johnson New Careers in Nursing, and for the AACN Gold Initiative to expand the Gold Foundation's White Coat Ceremony, which led to implementing the iconic ritual of humanism at New Jersey City University. She is also a member of the inaugural class of the International Center for Regulatory Scholarship.
